## THE HEART OF THE IP

"BE WHO YOU WANT TO BE AND HELP OTHERS DO THE SAME"

UNBOXABLES IS ABOUT EXPRESSING YOURSELF WHILST UNDERSTANDING OTHERS & FINDING COMMON GROUND THROUGH THE UNIVERSAL LANGUAGE OF PLAY - ALL WHILE HAVING #FUN!

Play is about connecting through imagination and fun, something kids do naturally.

When kids start to play, they quickly leave behind stereotypes – the "boxes" we put people in – and an **ARENA OF POSSIBILITY** opens up, because *every* kid "plays a different way", no two kids are the same.

And when kids rise to the challenge together and find a new way to play that is open and inclusive, it means more friends and a ton more fun.





## UNBOXABLE STORIES

Unboxables is set in a **toy multiverse** where ex YouTube Unboxed, toys live in different communities ....the "**Toytube Lots**".

Led by a Toy Youtuber "Rina" our stories follow the hilarious adventures of these toys in a land where you can be who you want to be. A demolition robot can express himself in the Lot of Arts and Crafts, a laughing Cuddly Bear is at home in the crash and bash of the Lot of Blocks and Wheels.

Whether 2 minute shorts for YouTube or longer episodes, our stories feature rich and colourful "Unboxable" Toy characters who explore what they can be as individuals and what they can achieve together as they learn to understand each other through play.











### DIGITAL FIRST STRATEGY: RINA'S PLAYDATES

Creative Format: Rina's Youtube videos of playdates with her friends from the Toytube Lots where they Unbox a toy and learn to play their way.....

Format: 3D Animated comedy adventure

Content: 10x2.5 min Playdates + clips, gags and compilations.

Target: Boys & Girls 3-6

Delivery: from May 24















## DIGITAL FIRST STRATEGY: UNBOX YOURSELF DANCE VIDEOS

Creative Format: UGC Live action plus animation. Rina and the gang dance along to Family UGC moves and grooves

Format: 3D Animated & UGC Mix

Content: Approx 200 dance videos from 20 secs to 30 minutes.

Target: Kids 3-6 & Parents

**Delivery: from August 24**

## EPISODE STRUCTURE

A parcel arrives addressed to a Toytube Lot, a Character or to Rina!
It could be a new Toy Character, or a Toy Thing

Short Musical interlude as Rina sets off on a magical train that links all the lots, waving at friends as she goes.

The parcel is opened ... ta da!

The story is sometimes centred around the unboxed Toy – a New Toy that's needs to find its home, or sometimes the unboxed toy is incidental.

Either way there will always be fun, adventure and lessons learned in how to play together.

Every episode ends in Rina and friends turning to camera and dancing us out to the Unboxables song!!!





## SPRINGBOARD FOR A "TOY THING"

The box is adressed Clank at the Lot of heroes and Villains.

Rina arrives to find a pitched battle (water balloon fight) with water bombs flying between the pirate ship and castle.

Clank comes down and they open the parcel..... it's a trampoline.

Clank puts across the castle ramparts, and it bounces back all of Skully's water bombs soaking her and her crew with friendly fire.

Skully thinks this a "no fair". Also, after basking in the glory of his master plan Clank realises this is no fun either....... Who likes a water bomb fight where you don't get wet?

Rina sets up the trampoline directly between Ship and the Castle and shows them how to bounce together. Then she says, "Open fire". They are caught in the cross-fire from both sides. Skully, Clank and Rina work together to deflect and pop the water bombs as they bounce up and down ...... Getting soaked and laughing all the way. This is the best water bomb battle ever they shout............ We end on Rina and Clank and Skully dancing us out to the Unbo song!!





## SPRINGBOARD FOR A "TOY CHARACTER"

Rina unboxes a bizarre character. T Dapper

A musical/Rapping T Rex that can body Pop. Wears dark glasses, large earphones, has gold chains around its neck and a large gold tooth.

He says his passion is fashion and style..... So Rina take him to the Giant Doll House that is Dress up a lot. T Rapper does indeed love all the outfits, beauty and glamour of all the various rooms but he is still a very boisterous Dinosaur whose bops and moves are causing havoc. Rina has a think. What about somewhere where you can wear what you want but its all about the groove....... She takes him to the land of Music and Dance. He and Didi get into a dance off ...... its amazing. Rina and the the others from the Dollhouse watch on cheering and chorus dancing. T Rapper has found his home.

T Rapper takes the Mic and raps his thanks to everyone... we dance our way out to a rap beat version of the UNBo theme.



## Webisode Structure

#### **SETUP**

Two randomly picked toys from two different lots meet in Rina's Arena.

A new surprise box is dropped and unboxed - it's a prop or playset that neither toy has encountered before.

Both toys have different ideas and excitedly launch into playing their own way.

Which leads to ... CHAOS!

#### **PROBLEM**

The two play patterns clash. One wants speed, the other one wants size. One wants to follow the rules, they other one wants to make them up.

With her trademark style and humour, Rina leads the toys to see if they can find a new way to play... together

#### RESOLUTION

They stop, listen to each other and start to play with some possibilities...

Soon they're lost in an AMAZING new game that no one's ever thought of before.

Most recent notable project: Piper's Pony Tales.






#### Kate Keenan & Lesley Halferty - Writers
